By-Law Number 47 - 2012

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be Incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes During the Year 2012

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2012 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2012 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 16-2012 on February 13, 2012; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held April 10, 2012, it was recommended to approve an allocation in the amount of \$3,725 to be funded through an appropriation from the City's Northwest Business Centre deferred revenue for the hiring of one summer student for the 2012 summer season for the Northwest Business Centre under the federal summer student program, and a further \$17,160 from deferred revenue for the creation of an Intern position for a one year period through the NOHFC Intern Program;

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That \$3,725 be funded through an appropriation from the City's Northwest Business Centre deferred revenue for the purpose of hiring one summer student through the federal summer student program at the Northwest Business Centre Office.
2. That \$17,160 be funded through an appropriation from the City's Northwest Business Centre deferred revenue for the purpose of creating an Intern position for a one year period through the NOHFC Intern Program.
3. That the 2012 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for these purposes.
4. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
