A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be Incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes During the Year 2011

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2011 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2011 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 40-2011 on April 18, 2011; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held May 14, 2012, it was recommended to approve an appropriation of an additional \$60,434.41 from the Keewatin Recreation Complex Reserve to cover the cost overage for the new compressors at the Kenora Recreation Centre; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** an appropriation in the amount of \$60,434.41 from the Keewatin Recreation Complex Reserve for the new compressors at the Kenora Recreation Centre; and
- 2. **That** the 2011 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
