By-Law Number 86 - 2012

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the sums required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2012

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2012 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2012 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 16-2012 on February 13, 2012; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held July 9, 2012, it was recommended to amend the Operating Budget for an appropriation from the JM Arena Reserve up to a maximum of \$65,000.00 to offset costs related to repairs and upgrades of the JM Arena for the purposes of occupancy compliance; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That approval be hereby authorized for an appropriation up to a maximum of \$65,000.00 to offset costs related to repairs and upgrades of the JM Arena for the purposes of occupancy compliance.
2. That the 2012 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.

By-Law Read a Third and Final time this 16 Day of July, 2012.
