By-law Number 3 – 2013

A By-law to amend By-law Number 148-2010 being a By-Law to Regulate the Discharge of Firearms, Air-Guns, Spring-Guns, Cross-Bows, Long-Bows or any Class or Type Thereof

Whereas By-law 148-2010 prohibits the discharge of any firearm or class or type thereof within a portion of the City of Kenora; and

Whereas Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend the by-law from time to time to meet changing requirements; and

Whereas at a meeting held January 14, 2013, it was recommended the by-law be amended to provide that trappers be exempt from the by-law during times when they are managing their registered trap line area;

Now therefore the Corporation of the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. That By-law Number 148-2010 be further amended by including the following provisions:

Under Section 2. Definition/Interpretation, add:

(i) "Registered trap line area" means an area designated as a trap line area in a Schedule to Part 1 of Ontario Regulation 663/98 (Area Descriptions) under the Ontario Fish & Wildlife Conservation Act, 1997.

(j) "**Trapper**" means a person licensed by the Ministry of Natural Resources to hunt or trap furbearing mammals in the area designated in the license.

Under Section 5. General Exemption, add:

5.6 A trapper licensed to manage their registered trap line area, provided the firearm is limited to a .22 caliber long rifle and exempted only in their registered trap line area; and further

2. That this By-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.

By-law Read a First and Second time this 21 day of January, 2013. By-law Read a Third and Final time this 21 day of January, 2013.
