By-Law Number 7 - 2013

A By-law to Include Property in a Register of Property Situation in the Municipality that is of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

Whereas Section 27(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, as amended, requires that the clerk of a municipality shall keep a register of property situated in the municipality that is of cultural heritage value or interest; and

Whereas Heritage Kenora, being the Heritage Committee of Council has recommended that certain properties be added to the municipal register; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to pass such a By-law;

Now Therefore Be it Resolved That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts the following with respect to the following:

1. That properties, or structures upon properties, described as:
 - i. 321 First Avenue South – Water Lot RP1965 PCL 3592 – Locally known as “The Blue Heron”
 - ii. 318 Third Street South - PLAN 3 BLK 2 LOT 54 – Locally known as “The Toole House”

are recommended by the Kenora Heritage Committee as being of cultural value or interest and are to be added to the register of property situated in the municipality;

2. That this by-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading thereof.
