By-Law Number 46 - 2013

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2012 and to amend the 2012 Water and Sewer Operating & Capital Budget

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2012 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2012 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 16-2012 on February 13, 2012; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2012 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budget by passing By-law Number 18-2012 on February 13, 2012; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held May 14, 2013, it was recommended to approve various reallocation of funds from the 2012 Municipal Capital Budget and the 2012 Water and Sewer Capital Budget to accommodate additional department requests; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the 2012 Water and Sewer Capital Budget is hereby amended to accommodate an additional request in the amount of \$28,000 plus applicable taxes, to address a Ministry of the Environment Drinking Water System Inspection Report 2011 recommendation for the supply, fabrication and on-site installation of vent/vacuum relief units for the Zone One, Zone Two and Keewatin Standpipes to be funded through the reallocation of \$20,000 from the Water Treatment Plant Variable Frequency Drive project and a reallocation of \$10,000 from the Water Treatment Plant Sludge Pump project, both approved under the 2012 Water and Sewer Capital Budget;
- 2. That the 2012 Municipal Capital Budget is hereby amended to combine the two \$80,000 budgets for the Street Flusher and Three Ton Truck to purchase two sidewalk plow;
- 3. That the 2012 Municipal Capital Budget is hereby amended to authorize additional funding for the McLeod Park Boardwalk and Railings Project in the amount of \$5,845.37 to be funded through the reallocation of this amount from the Sidewalks project;
- 4. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
