A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2013

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2013 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 22-2013 on March 18, 2013; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held May 14, 2013, it was recommended to approve an amendment to By-law Number 22-2013 to fund the incremental costs related to the negotiated settlement with CUPE Local 191 from the City's Contingency Reserve; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

- That By-law Number 22-2013 is hereby amended for the purpose of appropriating funds in the amount of \$131,000.00 from the City's Contingency Reserve to fund the incremental costs related to the CUPE agreement;
- 2. **That** the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. **That** this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
