By-Law Number 54 - 2013

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2013

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2013 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 22-2013 on March 18, 2013; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held May 14, 2013, it was recommended to approve an amendment to By-law Number 22-2013 for the purpose of performing a system audit for the Drinking Water Quality Management (DWQM) Standard in the amount of \$5,625.00 to be funded through the City's Water & Sewer Reserve; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** By-law Number 22-2013 is hereby amended for the purpose of a reallocation of funds from the City's Water & Sewer Reserve to cover the cost associated with the audit for the DWQM Standard in the amount of \$5,625.00;
- 2. **That** the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
