## **By-Law Number 67 – 2013**

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2013

**Whereas** Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2013 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 22-2013 on March 18, 2013; and

**Whereas** at a Committee of the Whole meeting held June 18, 2013, it was recommended to approve an amendment to By-law Number 22-2013 to provide for an additional budget allocation in the amount of \$55,000.00 plus disbursement costs to be funded through the City's Contingency Fund for the purchase of property described as 1539 Railway Street, Plan M123 Lot 39 & 40 for future municipal purposes; and

**Whereas** public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

**Now Therefore** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** By-law Number 22-2013 is hereby amended for the purpose of a reallocation of funds from the City's Contingency Reserves to purchase the property knows as 1539 Railway Street in the amount of \$55,000.00 plus disbursements;
- 2. **That** the 2013 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
