By-Law Number 68 – 2013

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2013

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2013 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 22-2013 on March 18, 2013; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held June 18, 2013, it was recommended to approve an amendment to By-law Number 22-2013 to provide for an additional budget allocation in the amount of \$50,000.00 to be funded through the City's Land Planning Reserves to accommodate additional requests from Heritage Kenora for incentives for rehabilitation and improvement to private lands in the Harbourtown Centre; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law Number 22-2013 is hereby amended for the purpose of a reallocation of funds from the City's Land Planning Reserve to accommodate additional requests from Heritage Kenora for incentives for rehabilitation and improvement to private lands in the Harbourtown Centre in the amount of \$50,000;
2. **That** the 2013 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
3. **That** this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
