By-law Number 105 – 2013

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2013

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2013 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2013 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 22-2013 on March 18, 2013; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held October 8, 2013, it was recommended to approve an amendment to By-law Number 22-2013 to provide for an additional budget allocation in the amount of \$16,900.00 to provide for the cost of a boiler for the Keewatin Memorial Arena; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law Number 22-2013 is hereby amended to reflect an amendment to the 2013 Operating & Capital budget to withdraw funds from the Keewatin Memorial Arena reserve in the amount of \$16,900.00 to offset the cost of a boiler for the Keewatin Memorial Arena approved in 2012 and installed in 2013;
- 2. That the 2013 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
