By-Law Number 71 - 2014

A By-law to Authorize the Transfer of Land to The Corporation of the City of Kenora

Whereas Subsection 31 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001, provides that a Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, establish a highway; and

Whereas after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law passed under subsection (1); and

Whereas the Corporation of the City of Kenora requires that a portion of the Worona Road, more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 23R 12257 Part of the South Part of Broken Lot 11, Concession 4, Township of Melick, now the City, District of Kenora, as surveyed out to be transferred to the City of Kenora as a condition of consent; and

Whereas the Corporation of the City of Kenora has reached an Agreement with Harold George Moncrief, Wendy Perrier, Robert Perrier and William Spencer Moncrief, to transfer the above described property for Municipal purposes and more particularly for a road, namely Worona Road;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. That lands affected by the By-law were acquired by the City for the purposes of a highway;
2. That the Corporation of the City of Kenora acquired from Harold George Moncrief, Wendy Perrier, Robert Perrier and William Spencer Moncrief, Part 1 on Plan 23R 12257 Part of the South Part of Broken Lot 11, Concession 4, Township of Melick, now the City , District of Kenora, designated as Part 5 Plan 23R 12225 PIN 42136-0221 being Worona Road, now in the City of Kenora, District of Kenora, as a highway for public/municipal purposes;
3. That the road is hereby named Worona Road;
4. That the purchase price of the said road shall not exceed the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00);
5. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required to complete this transaction.
6. That this By-law shall take effect and come into force from and after the final passing thereof.
