## By-Law Number 111 - 2014

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2014

**Whereas** Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2014 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2014 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 35-2014 on March 24, 2014; and

**Whereas** at a Committee of the Whole meeting held July 8, 2014, it was recommended to approve the reallocation of funds from the Contingency Reserve in the amount of \$100,000 and amending the 2014 Operating Budget for the purposes of funding a comprehensive Organizational Review for the City of Kenora; and

**Whereas** public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

**Now therefore** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That an appropriation in the amount of \$100,000 from the Contingency Reserve be hereby approved to fund the performance of a comprehensive Organizational Review for the City of Kenora;
- 2. That the 2014 Municipal Operating Budget and Five Year Capital Plan be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
