By-Law Number 22 – 2015

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2015

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2015 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2015 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 12-2015 and 13-2015 on February 17, 2015; and

Whereas at the Committee of the Whole meeting held March 10, 2015, an amendment was recommended to provide for an additional budget allocation in the amount of \$39,707.77 plus applicable taxes to be funded through the transit deferred revenue for the emergency replacement of the engine in the conventional transit bus; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment for an allocation of \$39,7007.77 plus applicable taxes to be funded from the transit deferred revenue for the purpose of an emergency engine replacement in the conventional transit;
2. That the 2015 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
