A By-law to amend the Keeping of Animals By-law Number 150 – 2010 to Authorize the Delegation of Variance Requests

Whereas Council adopted the Keeping of Animals By-law Number 150-2010 on the 9th day of August, 2010; and

Whereas at a meeting held March 10, 2015 it was deemed necessary and expedient to amend the by-law to meet changing requirements; and

Whereas Section 23.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under this or any other Act to a person or body, subject to certain restrictions; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation deems it expedient to delegate minor legislative matters with respect to the Keeping of Animals Bylaw, in which Council has explicitly provided for the terms and conditions under which the powers shall be exercised;

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 14.2 of bylaw number 150-2010 be hereby amended to read:
 - The City of Kenora's By-law Supervisor or the Manager for the Bylaw Supervisor may grant a variance as described in Sections 3.1 and 6.1 provided any information requested is provided and any conditions prescribed are agreed upon. This may include but is not limited to veterinary records and inspection of premises. The City's By-law Supervisor or the Manager for the Bylaw Supervisor will report any variances given to Council and may bring any variance to Council for decision at their discretion.
- 2. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect from and after the final passing thereof.
