By-Law Number 85 – 2015

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2015

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2015 Municipal Operating Budget and the 2015 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 12-2015 and 13-2015 on February 17, 2015; and

Whereas at the Committee of the Whole meeting held June 16, 2015, an amendment was recommended to approve a total project cost of \$160,000 for the purchase of drawings and a business case for a potential Event Centre to be funded through a \$30,000 fundraising allocation, \$50,000 from senior level of government and \$80,000 through Contingency Reserves; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a total project cost of \$160,000 for the purchase of drawings and a business case for a potential Event Centre to be funded through a \$30,000 fundraising allocation, \$50,000 from senior level of government and \$80,000 through Contingency Reserves.
- 2. That the 2015 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
