By-law Number 70 – 2016

A By-Law to Add a Set Fine for Bylaw Number 181-2008, a Bylaw that Establishes, Regulates and Maintains a Solid Waste Management System in the City of Kenora

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora established bylaw number 181-2008 being a bylaw that establishes, regulates and maintains a solid waste management system in the City of Kenora which also established set fines for enforcement of this bylaw; and

Whereas it has been determined that an additional set fine is required under this bylaw to incorporate a provision for dumping illegally on City Property; and

Whereas it is also determined that an enforcement provision be added to bylaw number 181-2008 to include a definition of a bylaw enforcement officer along with the enforcement provision;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- 1. That the attached Schedule "A" be hereby added to bylaw number 181-2008.
- 2. That the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora file a new application to the Regional Senior Justice, Ontario Court of Justice, Northwest Region, for an Order approving the set fine for the offences under the new bylaw which is attached as "Schedule A" to this bylaw.
- 3. That under bylaw 181-2008 the following be added:

2.0 "Definitions and Word Usage" – ADD:

"**by-law enforcement officer**" means a person appointed by the Council of the City to enforce the by-laws of the City.

ADD - 9.1 Enforcement

Orders Made Under Sections 444 and 445 of the Municipal Act, 2001

Any person who contravenes an order made under section 444 of the *Municipal Act,* 2001 is guilty of an offence.

Any person who contravenes an order made under section 445 of the *Municipal Act,* 2001 is guilty of an offence.

An order may be served:

- a) personally on the person to whom it is directed; or
- b) by registered or certified mail to the last known address of the person to whom it is directed, in which case it shall be deemed to have been given on the third day after it was mailed.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
