By-Law Number 100 – 2016

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2016

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2016 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 26-2016 on April 19, 2016 and further the 2016 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 40-2016 on May 17, 2016; and

Whereas at a Special Meeting of Council held September 6, 2016, an amendment was recommended for a re-allocation of \$30,000 to be funded through the Contingency Reserves for completing the Keewatin Memorial Arena Metal Roof Installation project which has a budget of \$360,000 but requires \$383,587.18 plus an approximate \$2,500 building permit fee to complete as per lowest bid price received; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a re-allocation of \$30,000 to be funded through the Contingency Reserves for completing the Keewatin Memorial Arena Metal Roof Installation project which has a budget of \$360,000 but requires \$383,587.18 plus an approximate \$2,500 building permit fee to complete as per lowest bid price received.
- 2. That the 2016 Municipal Operating and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
