By-Law Number 111 – 2016

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2016

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2016 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 26-2016 on April 19, 2016 and further the 2016 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 40-2016 on May 17, 2016; and

Whereas at the Committee of the Whole meeting held October 4, 2016, an amendment was recommended for the 2016 operating budget to appropriate \$234,698.94 from the City's Contingency Reserve to fund the incremental wage and benefits costs for 2014 through 2016 related to the Interest Arbitration Award with the Kenora Professional Fire Fighters Association; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice Bylaw Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment to appropriate \$234,698.94 from the City's Contingency Reserve to fund the incremental wage and benefits costs for 2014 through 2016 related to the Interest Arbitration Award with the Kenora Professional Fire Fighters Association.
- 2. That the 2016 Municipal Operating budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
