By-Law Number 116 - 2016

A By-Law to Execute a Funding Agreement for the Ontario Provincial Police for the Additional Officer Program Under the Safer Communities 1,000 Officers Partnership Program between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as Represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services, the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora Police Services Board.

Whereas the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute an Agreement with Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Ontario as Represented by The Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services, the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora Police Services Board for the Safer Communities – 1,000 Officers Partnership Program;

Now Therefore, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That** the CAO of the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Chair of the Kenora Police Services Board be and are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, between Her Majesty The Queen In Right of Ontario as Represented by The Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services, the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Kenora Police Services Board, in accordance with the terms and conditions therein;
- 2. That** this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
