## **By-Law Number 123 - 2016**

A By-Law to authorize the Execution of a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation Community Capacity Funding for the Kenora Rowing Club Site Improvements

Whereas at a Regular meeting of Council held October 18, 2016 authorization was given to enter into an agreement with the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for the Community Capacity Funding Program; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute a project date amendment to this agreement between the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation and the Corporation of the City of Kenora provision of site improvements to the Kenora Rowing Club in preparation to host the 2017 Canada Summer Games Rowing Venue;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an amending agreement with the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for the Kenora Rowing Club site improvements.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
