By-Law Number 37 - 2017

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2016

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2016 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 26-2016 on April 19, 2016 and further the 2016 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 40-2016 on May 17, 2016; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole meeting held March 14, 2017, an amendment was recommended for an appropriation from the City's Contingency Reserve to fund the incremental wage and benefit costs related to the 2016 negotiated settlement with CUPE Local 191; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. That hereby authorizes and appropriation from the City's Contingency Reserve to offset the to fund the incremental wage and benefit costs related to the CUPE agreement;
2. That the 2016 Municipal Operating Budget and Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose;
3. That this by-Law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
