By-Law Number 51 - 2017

A By-Law to authorize the Execution of an Amendment for a Funding Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for the Improvements to the Kenora Rowing Club Site

Whereas at a Regular Meeting of Council held February 16, 2016, Council Resolution Number 11, Council authorized a funding application to NOHFC for improvements to the Kenora Rowing Club; and

Whereas an original agreement was reached between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and NOHFC, the provision of this agreement will improve the Kenora Rowing Club site, develop the course, launch docks and allow for the acquisition of equipment in preparation of hosting the 2017 Canada Summer Games, Rowing Venue; and

Whereas an original agreement with NOHFC in the amount of \$184,750 was executed on October 18, 2016; and

Whereas the City has requested additional funding from NOHFC for an additional \$84,750 to offset a funding shortfall; and

Whereas the City has been approved for the additional funding bringing the total funding amount to \$269,500; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute an amending agreement between the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation and The Corporation of the City of Kenora to provide funding for the Kenora Rowing Club Site Improvements;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into an amending agreement with the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation for the Kenora Rowing Club Site Improvements.
2. That the CAO of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
