Bylaw Number 71 - 2017

A Bylaw to End the Application of Part IX of the Municipal Act, 2001; "Limitation on Taxes for Certain Property Classes"

Whereas the Municipality may, in accordance with the terms and provisions of Ontario Regulation 73/03 as made and amended under The Act, pass a bylaw ending the application of Part IX of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "The Act"), for the Multi-Residential, Commercial and Industrial property classes; and

Whereas for the purposes of this bylaw the Commercial classes shall be considered a single property class and the Industrial classes shall be deemed to be a single property class;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts the following in respect of the application of Part IX of the Act:

- 1. That having determined that the eligibility requirements set out under Section 8.2 of Ontario Regulation 73/03 have been met in respect of the Multi-Residential, Commercial and Industrial property classes, The Municipality opts to end the application of Part IX of The Act for these classes for the 2017 and subsequent taxation years.
- 2. That this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final reading.
