

# **Corporation of the City of Kenora**

## **Bylaw Number 71 - 2017**

### **A Bylaw to End the Application of Part IX of the Municipal Act, 2001; “Limitation on Taxes for Certain Property Classes”**

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Whereas the Municipality may, in accordance with the terms and provisions of Ontario Regulation 73/03 as made and amended under The Act, pass a bylaw ending the application of Part IX of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 c.25, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “The Act”), for the Multi-Residential, Commercial and Industrial property classes; and

Whereas for the purposes of this bylaw the Commercial classes shall be considered a single property class and the Industrial classes shall be deemed to be a single property class;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts the following in respect of the application of Part IX of the Act:

1. That having determined that the eligibility requirements set out under Section 8.2 of Ontario Regulation 73/03 have been met in respect of the Multi-Residential, Commercial and Industrial property classes, The Municipality opts to end the application of Part IX of The Act for these classes for the 2017 and subsequent taxation years.
2. That this bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final reading.
