A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Jennifer Schott for the Operation of the Keewatin Arena Concession

Whereas a request for proposals for the supply of food and beverage concession services for the Keewatin Arena was advertised; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole held August 8, 2017 the report was discussed by Council and direction to execute an agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Jennifer Schott for the operation of the Keewatin Arena concession; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to authorize execution of the agreement between Jennifer Schott and the Corporation of the City of Kenora;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute an agreement between the City of Kenora and Jennifer Schott in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in the attached Schedule for the period of September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2020.
- That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to execute the addendum on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions outlined in the agreement attached hereto and forming part of this By-law and to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
