## **By-law Number 103 - 2017**

## A By-law to Authorize a an Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Streetscan Canada Inc. for Pavement Inspection and Management Services in the City of Kenora

Whereas Council directed administration to continue to improve data contained in the 2016 Asset Management Plan for the City of Kenora prepared by Public Sector Digest (PSD) including underlying the plan and strategies with which to manage the City's infrastructure; and

Whereas at the August 8, 2017 regular meeting of Council, Council directed staff to apply for a grant opportunity from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program for a Road Needs Assessment which would strengthen this data; and

Whereas StreetScan Canada Inc. will commence data collection prior to the FCM grant approval with the agreement that the municipality proceed with data processing upon FCM funding approval; and

Whereas should this funding opportunity for this program not be successful, administration will bring the matter back to Council for consideration and the processing of the data will not be completed until funding is secured;

Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. Council hereby authorizes an Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Streetscan Canada Inc. for the provision of Pavement Inspection and Management Services in the City of Kenora.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora.
