## By-Law Number 111 - 2017

## A By-law to Authorize a Load Restriction for the Coker Bridge

Whereas the Coker Bridge conditions are deteriorating and based on the inspection and analysis of the bridge, the City has been advised it is recommended that a load restriction should be instituted for the structure; and

Whereas the Council of the City of Kenora deems it expedient to prohibit certain heavy traffic over the Coker Bridge to prohibit construction trucks, equipment, tractor trailers and large fire vehicles traversing this bridge; and

Whereas Section 123 (2) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, provides authority for the Municipal Council to limit the gross vehicle weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over the bridge; and

Whereas at Committee of the Whole meeting on September 5, 2017 Council approved a load restriction of a 20 tonne Gross Vehicle Weight for the Coker Bridge effective immediately; and

Every person who contravenes this bylaw is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, under the Provincial Offences Act.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That a load restriction of a 20 tonne Gross Vehicle Weight for the Coker Bridge be in effect.
- 2. That this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading.
