By-Law Number 130 – 2017

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2017

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2017 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 35-2017 on March 21, 2017; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2017 Municipal Operating Budget by passing bylaw number 74-2017 on June 5, 2017; and

Whereas at a Special Council meeting held August 8, 2017, an amendment was recommended for an additional allocation of \$285,000 to be funded through the transfer of two Capital items: \$75,000 (Re-aeration Tank Maintenance) and \$210,000 (Water Main Program), for the Crawford Lift Station Rehabilitation works

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes an additional allocation of \$285,000 to be funded through the transfer of two Capital items: \$75,000 (Re-aeration Tank Maintenance) and \$210,000 (Water Main Program), for the Crawford Lift Station Rehabilitation works.
2. That the 2017 Municipal Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
