By-Law Number 133 – 2017

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Operating and Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2017

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2017 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 35-2017 on March 21, 2017; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2017 Municipal Operating Budget by passing bylaw number 74-2017 on June 5, 2017; and

Whereas at a Committee of the Whole Council meeting held November 14, 2017, a budget amendment was recommended Council for participation in FCM's Climate Asset Management Network to integrate climate risks into the City's 2016 Asset Management Plan with a total project cost of \$105,00.00 and \$21,000.00 to be allocated funding from contingency reserve with FCM funding the remaining 80 percent of total project costs;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment of \$105,00.00 of which \$21,000.00 to be allocated funding from contingency reserve with FCM funding the remaining 80 percent of total project costs for participation in FCM's Climate Asset Management Network to integrate climate risks into the City's 2016 Asset Management Plan.
2. That the 2017 Municipal Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
