By-law Number 156 - 2017

A By-law to Authorize a Memorandum of Understanding between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Lake of the Woods Development Commission, Lake of the Woods Employment Action Project, Lake of the Woods Business Incentive Corporation, Seven Generations Education Institute, Shooniyaa Wa-Biitong , Kenora and District Chamber of Commerce, Kenora Hospitality Alliance, Lake of the Woods Brewing Company, Harbourtown BIZ, Northwest Training and Adjustment Board, Kenora District Services Board, Northwest Business Centre, Ne-Chee Friendship Centre and Confederation College for a Pathways to Employment in Kenora Services Sector agreement

Whereas at the December 7th, 2017 regular meeting of the Committee of the Whole, Council identified partners to lead implementation of the recommendations within the Pathways to Employment in Kenora Services Sector; and

Whereas as part of the funding commitment for this program a formalized partnership agreement is required amongst all the key informants that have been involved with specific deliverables;

Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

1. Council hereby authorizes a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the Lake of the Woods Development Commission, Lake of the Woods Employment Action Project, Lake of the Woods Business Incentive Corporation, Seven Generations Education Institute, Shooniyaa Wa-Biitong , Kenora and District Chamber of Commerce, Kenora Hospitality Alliance, Lake of the Woods Brewing Company, Harbourtown BIZ, Northwest Training and Adjustment Board, Kenora District Services Board, Northwest Business Centre, Ne-Chee Friendship Centre and Confederation College for a Pathways to Employment in Kenora Services Sector agreement.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to execute the MOU on behalf of the City of Kenora.
