## **By-Law Number 56 – 2018**

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2018

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2018 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 9-2018 on February 20, 2018; and

Whereas at the Committee of the Whole meeting held May 15, 2018, an amendment was recommended for an additional allocation of \$51,000.25 to be funded through the AMO Main Street Revitalization Initiative funding to further implement the wayfinding program in the Harbourtown Centre; and

Whereas Council authorized amending its 2018 Capital Budget at its May 22, 2018 meeting in the amount of \$51,000.25 to the Wayfinding Part II budget for this project; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes an allocation of \$51,000.25 to be funded through the AMO Main Street Revitalization Initiative funding for the wayfinding program in Harbourtown Centre.
- 2. That the 2018 Municipal Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
