A By-Law Removing a Restrictive Covenant

Whereas pursuant to the provisions of Section 119 of the Land Titles Act, the Council of a local municipality may, by by-law, delete restrictions placed upon lands; and

Whereas Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it in the public interest to pass a by-law to remove a restrictive covenant;

Now therefore, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

- That the restriction placed upon land described as Block A of Plan of Subdivision M-660, being PIN # 42134-0217, in the City of Kenora, to prevent the erection of buildings, be deleted in accordance with Section 119 of the Land Titles Act;
- 2. That by deleting the restriction, the registered owner will be permitted to erect an accessory building on the lands;
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of the Land Titles Act, this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora and upon registration of this by-law in the Land Titles Office for the District of Kenora.
