## A By-Law to Authorize Execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and NORDIK Institute for the Northwest Business Centre ONE Social Enterprise Partnership

Whereas the Northwest Business Centre is collaborating with the ONE Social Enterprise Partnership, Northern Region, comprised of Timmins Economic Development Corporation's Business Enterprise Centre, YouLaunch, a division of the Sault Ste. Marie Innovation Centre in Sault Ste. Marie, the Northwest Regional Innovation Centre in Thunder Bay and PARO Centre for Women's Enterprise in Thunder Bay; and

Whereas the partnership is funded, in part, by the Ministry of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade; and

Whereas NORDIK Institute and Northwest Business Centre wish to engage regional ONE members, business development service providers, social enterprises and aspiring entrepreneurs in said social enterprise development;

- 3. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute any documents to give effect to this agreement;
