## By-Law Number 143 – 2018

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2018

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2018 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 9-2018 on February 20, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2018 Municipal Operating Budget by passing bylaw number 72-2018 on May 22, 2018; and

Whereas at the Special Council meeting held October 31, 2018, Council approved an allocation of \$46,000.00 plus applicable taxes to be funded equally through the Solid Waste Equipment Reserve and the Equipment Reserve for the purchase of parts and labor to rebuild the engines of two co-mingle trucks; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby authorizes an allocation of \$46,000.00 plus applicable taxes to be funded equally through the Solid Waste Equipment Reserve and the Equipment Reserve for the purchase of parts and labor to rebuild the engines of two co-mingle trucks.
- 2. That the 2018 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
