## **By-Law Number 36 – 2019**

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas at the Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting held March 12, 2019, Council recommended an additional allocation of \$55,000 to be funded through the Solid Waste Reserve to supplement the difference between the \$340,000 set aside in the 2019 Capital Budget for the construction of the Transfer Station Scale Building Expansion and the accepted tender submitted by L.M.D. Contracting (2008) in the amount of \$336,200 (plus applicable taxes); and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes an additional allocation of \$55,000 to be funded through the Solid Waste Reserves.
- 2. That the 2019 Municipal Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
