A By-law to Amend Comprehensive Zoning By-law 101-2015

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora passed Comprehensive Zoning By-law No. 101-2015 on December 15, 2015; and

Whereas Council passed a By-law to amend By-Law 101-2015, being By-law 140-2018;

Whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient to repeal By-Law 140-2018;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Kenora Enacts as follows:

1. That By-law 140-2018, passed on October 31st, 2018 to rezone property located in the area of Pine Portage Road, being Lots 25 through 37, and a portion of a laneway described on Plan M63; being approximately 0.8 hectares of property; to change the zoning of property as identified from Highway Commercial (HC) to Institutional (I), to allow for development of those uses permitted within the Institutional Zone, being public and privately owned facilities of an institutional or community service nature in accordance with Section 4.14 of the Zoning By-law; is repealed in its entirety.
