By-Law Number 47 – 2019

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas at the Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting held April 9, 2019, Council recommended an additional \$100,000 in bridge maintenance costs to be funded through the bridge audit reserves for preventative bridge maintenance and repairs as identified in the 2018 Biennial Bridge Inspection Report; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby authorizes an additional allocation of \$100,000 in bridge maintenance costs to be funded through the bridge audit reserves for preventative bridge maintenance and repairs as identified in the 2018 Biennial Bridge Inspection Report.
- 2. That the 2019 Municipal Capital Budget be and is hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
