By-Law Number 51 – 2019

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas at the Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting held April 9, 2019, Council recommended a budget amendment to the Pickle Ball Project to increase the total project cost from \$120,361 to \$131,789 based on the results of the low bid in the RFP process, with offsetting funding being provided through donations already raised; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment to the Pickle Ball Project to increase the total project cost from \$120,361 to \$131,789 based on the results of the low bid in the RFP process, with offsetting funding being provided through donations already raised.
2. That any funds received after April 16, 2019 will be applied to the overall project cost increasing the scope of works as the funds are available.
3. That the 2019 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
