By-Law Number 76 – 2019

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held May 14, 2019, Council recommended a capital budget carry over in the amount of \$57,546.50 plus applicable taxes to fund the Keewatin Arena Fire Alarm System Replacement project which was a 2018 capital project which was not completed in the 2018 budget year; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment in the amount of \$57,546.50 plus applicable taxes for the completion of the Keewatin Arena Fire Alarm System Replacement project to be funded through contingency reserves.
- 2. That the 2019 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
