By-Law Number 144 – 2019

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held September 10, 2019, Council supported an additional allocation of \$779,842 to be funded through the Art Centre capital project funds which have come solely from senior levels of government and private donations for the construction of the Douglas Family Art Centre; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby approves an additional allocation of \$779,842 to be funded through the Art Centre capital project funds which have come solely from senior levels of government and private donations for the construction of the Douglas Family Art Centre to offset the cost of the construction and related capital expenses.
- 2. That the 2019 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
