By-Law Number 167 - 2019

A By-law to amend By-law Number 148-2007 being the Comprehensive Policy Manual for the Corporation of the City of Kenora

Whereas on December 10, 2007 Council adopted By-Law Number 148-2007, adopting the Comprehensive Policy Manual and approving it as the Official Municipal Policy Manual for the City of Kenora; and

Whereas from time to time policies to the Manual are added, removed and amended; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend By-law Number 148-2007 to meet changing requirements with respect to various municipal policies; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole meeting November 12, 2019 Council recommended to adopt a new Health & Safety Senior Leadership Team Health & Safety Continuous Improvement Policy #HS-48 at its November 19, 2019 Council Meeting; and

Whereas Council further recommended the repeal of several Health and Safety Policies that are no longer required for various purposes including #HS-49 Senior Management–Review of Trends, #HS-50 Senior Management-Response to Recommendations, #HS-51 Senior Management–Communications, #HS-52 Senior Management–Integration, #HS-53 Senior Management – Program Review, #HS-54 Senior Management–Off-the-job Health and Safety, and #HS-55 Senior Management–CAO Involvement;

Now Therefore the Council of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- 1. That a new Health & Safety Senior Leadership Team Health & Safety Continuous Improvement Policy #HS-48 attached hereto be hereby approved.
- 2. That this Policy shall form part of the Comprehensive Policy Manual.
- 3. That Policy #HS-49 Senior Management–Review of Trends, #HS-50 Senior Management-Response to Recommendations, #HS-51 Senior Management–Communications, #HS-52 Senior Management–Integration, #HS-53 Senior Management Program Review, #HS-54 Senior Management–Off-the-job Health and Safety, and #HS-55 Senior Management–CAO Involvement approved by bylaw number 27-2012 be hereby repealed.
- 4. That this By-law shall take effect and come into force upon third and final reading.
