## By-Law Number 185 – 2019

## A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held December 10, 2019, Council supported a re-allocation of \$285,000.00 (plus applicable taxes) to be funded through the sewer and water reserves for completing an emergency replacement of existing OmniSite Radios at the City's fifty-eight (58) different locations, including the Water Treatment Plant, Wastewater Treatment Plant, Water Booster Stations, and Sewage Pumping Stations; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- That Council hereby approves a re-allocation of \$285,000.00 (plus applicable taxes)
  to be funded through the sewer and water reserves for completing an emergency
  replacement of existing OmniSite Radios at the City's fifty-eight (58) different
  locations, including the Water Treatment Plant, Wastewater Treatment Plant, Water
  Booster Stations, and Sewage Pumping Stations.
- 2. That the 2019 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
