A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2020

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 174-2019 on December 17, 2019; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 2-2020 on January 28, 2020; and

Whereas Council of the city of Kenora adopted the 2020 Solid Waste Five Year Capital Plan and Operating budget by passing By-law Number 4-2020 on January 28, 2020; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 11, 2020 Council recommended an additional allocation of \$315,153 to be funded through the Solid Waste Reserve for two Capital Projects that were not completed in 2019; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007:

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment for an additional allocation of \$315,153 to be funded through the Solid Waste Reserve for two Capital Projects that were not completed in 2019.
- 2. That the 2020 Municipal Capital, Operating and Solid Waste Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
