By-Law Number 32 - 2020

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2019 and 2020

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 147-2018 on December 18, 2018; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2019 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 32-2016 on March 19, 2019; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 174-2019 on December 17, 2019; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 2-2020 on January 28, 2020; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 11, 2020 Council recommended a budget amendment for the City Hall Second Floor Security Partition Renovation project to be funded through Health and Safety Reserves (2019) in the amount of \$9,906.20 and Health and Safety Reserves (2020) in the amount of \$3,816.00 for a total budget amendment in the amount of \$13,722.20; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment for the City Hall Second Floor Security Partition Renovation project to be funded through Health and Safety Reserves (2019) in the amount of \$9,906.20 and Health and Safety Reserves (2020) in the amount of \$3,816.00 for a total budget amendment in the amount of \$13,722.20.
- 2. That the 2019 and 2020 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
