By-Law Number 33 - 2020

A By-Law to Adopt Amended Estimates for Capital Reserves to be incorporated into the Sums Required for Municipal Purposes during the Year 2020

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Five Year Capital Plan by passing By-law Number 174-2019 on December 17, 2019; and

Whereas Council of the City of Kenora adopted the 2020 Municipal Operating Budget by passing By-law Number 2-2020 on January 28, 2020; and

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 11, 2020 Council recommended a budget amendment in the amount of \$553,008.90 for the Kenora Sportsplex Mezzanine Renovations project related to the project that remains in progress; and

Whereas at the same Regular Committee of the Whole Meeting of Council held February 11, 2020 Council further recommended an additional budget amendment of \$2,621 related to costs for Architectural review and building permit to be taken from contingency reserves; and

Whereas public notice of this amendment has been given in accordance with Notice By-law Number 144-2007;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Council hereby authorizes a budget amendment in the amount of \$553,008.90 for the Kenora Sportsplex Mezzanine Renovations project related to the project that remains in progress.
2. That Council hereby authorizes an additional budget amendment of \$2,621 related to costs for Architectural review and building permit to be taken from contingency reserves.
3. That the 2020 Municipal Capital and Operating Budgets be and are hereby amended for this purpose.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on final passing.
