A By-Law to authorize the Execution of an Agreement between the Northwest Business Centre and the Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade for the Provision of a Summer Company Initiative and Starter Company Plus Initiative

Whereas at a Regular meeting of Council held March 31, 2020 authorization was given to enter into an agreement with the Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade for the provision of a Summer Company Initiative and Starter Company Plus Initiative, which will provide business training, mentoring and capital for youth to start and run their own summer business in the Kenora area; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute this agreement between the Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade and the Corporation of the City of Kenora;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- That authorization is hereby given for the Corporation of the City of Kenora to enter into an agreement with the Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade for the provision of a Summer Company Initiative and Starter Company Plus Initiative.
- 2. That the CAO of the Corporation of the City of Kenora be and is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the Northwest Business Centre in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
