## **By-Law Number 76 - 2020**

A By-Law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as Represented by the Minister of Employment and Social Development and the Corporation of the City of Kenora

Whereas it was determined that the Corporation of the City of Kenora is eligible for a grant under the Enabling Accessibility Fund for providing accessible parking spaces in front of the splash pad, a pathway from the washroom to the beach and finally, an accessible mat that will allow for wheelchairs to have access from the beach to the water; and

Whereas it is deemed necessary and expedient to authorize the Articles of Agreement between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of

Employment and the Corporation of the City of Kenora in respect to the terms and conditions

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:-

- 3. That this By-law shall take effect and come into force on the third and final reading thereof.
