By-Law Number 99 - 2020

A By-Law to Execute a Water and Sewer Services Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Wauzhushk Onigum Nation

Whereas on or about August 16, 2018, discussions began between Wauzhushk Onigum Nation and the City of Kenora for water and sewer service connection from the City of Kenora's distribution and collection system to the First Nations Community; and

Whereas on September 25, 2018 Council issued a letter of intent regarding the City's willingness to work towards an Agreement wherein the residents of Wauzhushk Onigum Nation would receive City water and sewer services and essentially lift the existing boil water order that has been in place for the First Nation for many years; and

Whereas through ongoing vision and dedication by Chief and Council of Wauzhushk Onigum Nation and Council of the City of Kenora, this important and historic Agreement has now been achieved; and

Whereas the signing of this Agreement and the resulting project represent an important milestone in the relationship between our two communities;

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute a Water and Sewer Services Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and Wauzhushk Onigum Nation.
2. That this By-Law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
