## A By-Law to authorize the Execution of a Community Gift Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the CMA Foundation for COVID-19 Community Response Funding for Vulnerable Populations

Whereas at a Regular Committee of the Whole meeting held July 14, 2020, Council authorized a Community Gift Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the CMA Foundation for COVID-19 Community Response Funding for Vulnerable Populations; and

Whereas Council authorizes the donation to be transferred, on behalf of the City, to the Kenora District Services Board (KDSB) who is the service delivery agency for social programs including social housing, homelessness programs, and emergency medical services/land ambulance

Whereas Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora deems it necessary and expedient to execute a Community Gift Agreement Between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the CMA Foundation for COVID-19 Community Response Funding for Vulnerable Populations;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kenora hereby enacts as follows:-

- That authorization is hereby given for the City of Kenora to enter into the execution of a Community Gift Agreement between the Corporation of the City of Kenora and the CMA Foundation for COVID-19 Community Response Funding for Vulnerable Populations.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City of Kenora in accordance with the terms and conditions set out therein and to affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.
